CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ELIZABETH BRADY AND JOHN H. JACOBSON
7130 SMULLIN ROAD
MT. HOOD, OREGON 97041

confirms the right to use the waters of ALDER CREEK, a tributary of HOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 18.32 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 124. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 10, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.315 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 9, T 1 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 120 rods (1,980') E and 70 rods (1,155') S of NW corner of Sec. 9.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 8.30 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 5.42 ACRES
SECTION 4

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 4.60 ACRES
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 459, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 16 2005, approving Transfer Application 8644.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
