CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ELIZABETH BRADY AND JOHN H. JACOBSON 7130 SMULLIN ROAD MT. HOOD, OREGON 97041

confirms the right to use the waters of ALDER CREEK and EAST FORK OF HOOD RIVER, a tributary of HOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 7.98 acres and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 5.32 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 21508. The date of priority is May 21, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 0.09 CFS FROM EAST FORK HOOD RIVER AND 0.08 CFS FROM ALDER CREEK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

East Fork Hood River: NW¼ NW¼, SECTION 9, T 1 S, R 10 E, W.M. Alder Creek: SW¼ NE¼, SECTION 9, T 1 S, R 10 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
