CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

A. L. BOCOCK GRANTS PASS, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.85 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is 1887.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1 cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE'4 NW'4, SECTION 27, T 39 S, R 8 W, W.M.; KERBY DITCH 1,650 FEET SOUTH AND 1,800 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 27.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ 2.85 ACRES

SECTION 4

TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
