## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EDWARD HASSLER 470 SE CHURCH STREET SUBLIMITY, OREGON 97385

confirms the right to use the waters of HASSLER WELL 2 in the MILL CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 45.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-490. The date of priority is MARCH 4, 1957. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.57 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

LOT 3 (SE% NE%), SECTION 2, T 9 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 200 FEET NORTH AND 1430 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 2 (SW% NE%) 5.8 ACRES LOT 3 (SE% NE%) 6.0 ACRES NE% SE% 17.6 ACRES NW% SE% 16.2 ACRES SECTION 2

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 28361, State Record of Water Right Certificates, cancelled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 29, 2004, approving Transfer Application T-9274. The order was reconsidered and the transfer application withdrawn by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FFB 2.4 2005

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
