CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GORDON B. PAUSTIAN  
ROUTE 1, BOX 10J  
HAINES, OREGON 97833

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the POWDER RIVER basin for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 16.08 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7090. The date of priority is November 16, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 0.20 cubic foot per second (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 57147, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director

entered March 9, 2005, and recorded in Special Order Volume 63, Page 375, canceling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 820401.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
