CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BLANCHE B. PETERS FAMILY TRUST WILFRED B. PETERS AND BRENDA BRAXMEYER, TRUSTEES 44034 NW KEMPER ROAD FOREST GROVE, OREGON 97116

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR CONSRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2647, a tributary of WEST FORK DAIRY CR, for IRRIGATION OF 17.2 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 12.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-27512. The date of priority is AUGUST 23, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.28 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 0.16 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.12 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-2647.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
