CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

G W WILEY
POST OR 97752

confirms the right to use the waters of NEWSOME and CAMP CREEKS, tributaries of the CROOKED RIVER, for DOMESTIC, LIVESTOCK, and IRRIGATION of 82 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1880 for irrigation of 30 acres, and 1890 for irrigation of 52 acres. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and livestock use, and 1.03 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 680, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 13 2005, approving Transfer Application 9758. It corrects the inaccurate irrigation season listed on Certificate 680, making it consistent with that specified in the Crooked River decree (February 1 to December 1). The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
