CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RON HOLEMAN BOX 617 ECHO, OREGON 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS #1 and 2, within the UMATILLA RIVER basin, for IRRIGATION OF 329.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8369. The date of priority is OCTOBER 20, 1978. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 4.12 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

SE¼ SE¼, SECTION 21, T 3 N, R 29 E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 720 FEET NORTH AND 530 FEET WEST; WELL 2 - 370 FEET NORTH AND 530 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 21;

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:
