 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
 WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the TUMALO CREEK tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-27840. The date of priority is DECEMBER 8, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed the following monthly quantities, measured at the point of diversion:

The total seasonal duty is 1,976.50 acre-feet.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

In Tumalo Creek, from the location of the Tumalo Feed Canal Diversion authorized previously under Certificate 76106, located approximately at:

To the mouth of Tumalo Creek, and then in the Deschutes River from the mouth of Tumalo Creek to Lake Billy Chinook.

The instream right established by this allocation of conserved water shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 76106, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 64, Page 157, finalizing the allocation and assignment of conserved water application C-9.
