CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That R. L. Duvall

of Mosier, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Two Springs, tributaries to Mosier Creek,

for the purpose of Domestic and Stock;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 10, at page 43; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 of a cubic foot per second;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

SE 1/4 of Section 7,
T. 2 N., R. 12 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
