CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GENE BLEAK

confirms the right to use the waters of THE ROGUE RIVER AND LOST CREEK RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8142, for IRRIGATION OF 3.0 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 8.3 ACRES AND MAINTENANCE OF FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM.

This right has been perfected under Permit 48276. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 1, 1984. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.0475 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.0375 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.01 CFS FOR FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM FROM THE ROGUE RIVER AND 9.0 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION FROM LOST CREEK RESERVOIR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 590 FEET NORTH AND 1340 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract 4-07-10-W0514 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

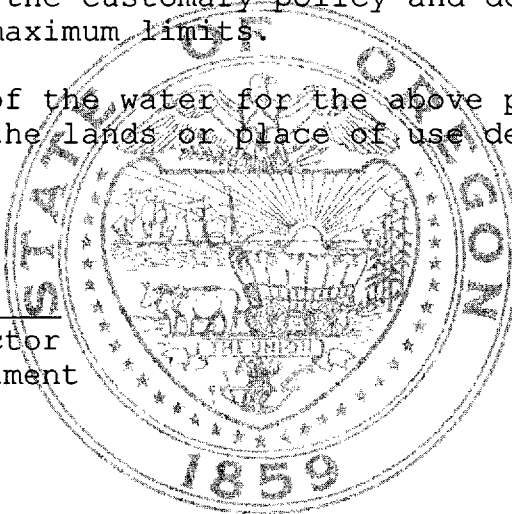

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed 2 ½ acre-feet per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been raised to 4 ½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
