CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H. H. Taylor
Ruch, Oregon

confirms the right to use the waters of Little Applegate, a tributary of Applegate River, for IRRIGATION of 8.0 acres, and Domestic and Stock.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is September 1, 1857.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.16 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows: Farmers Ditch; Northeast Quarter (NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Thirty-nine (39) South, Range Three (3) West of the Willamette Meridian.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 16406 , State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 09 2005 , approving Transfer Applications 8950 and 8951 and correctly describes the location of the point of diversion (Special Order Volume 1, Page 256).

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
