CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STANLEY E. TENOLD

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH MYRTLE CREEK, a tributary of MYRTLE CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 10.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 47919. The date of priority is JULY 13, 1983 FOR 0.095 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) AND AUGUST 11, 1983 FOR 0.036 CFS. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.131 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.126 FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

DOMESTIC - LOT 6 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 2235 FEET SOUTH AND 1100 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13; AND

IRRIGATION - LOT 5 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 2160 FEET SOUTH AND 1715 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4            2.1 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 49  
LOT 5 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4)    7.1 ACRES  
LOT 6 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4)    0.9 ACRE AND DOMESTIC  
SECTION 13  
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
