CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED CREEK, a tributary of STAHLMAN CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND LANDSCAPE BEAUTIFICATION.

This right was perfected under Permit 30922. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 17, 1965. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M.;  
NORTH 70 DEGREES 30 MINUTES EAST, 1881 FEET FROM THE SW CORNER,  
SECTION 12; and

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M.;  
NORTH 68 DEGREES EAST, 1865 FEET FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 12.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
