A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of LABOR AND INDUSTRIES WELL 1 in the MILL CREEK BASIN for AIR CONDITIONING.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1363. The date of priority is JUNE 10, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.78 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within WILSON DLC 44 (LOT 6, BLOCK 82, SALEM), SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.; 110 FEET SOUTH AND 50 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 26.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


