confirms the right to store the waters of UNNAMED STREAMS, TRIBUTARY OF BERRY CREEK IN THREE RESERVOIRS for LIVESTOCK, FIRE PROTECTION AND FLOOD CONTROL.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-75387. The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and used each year under this right is not more than 3.75 ACRE-FEET, BEING 1.0 AF IN HAMILTON 5 RESERVOIR, 0.75 AF IN HAMILTON 6 RESERVOIR AND 2.0 AF IN HAMILTON 7 RESERVOIR.

Located as follows:

RES 5 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, WM.
RES 6 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, WM.
RES 7 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, WM.
RES 7 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, WM.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with a minimum diameter of 8", or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as determined by the Water Resources Director.



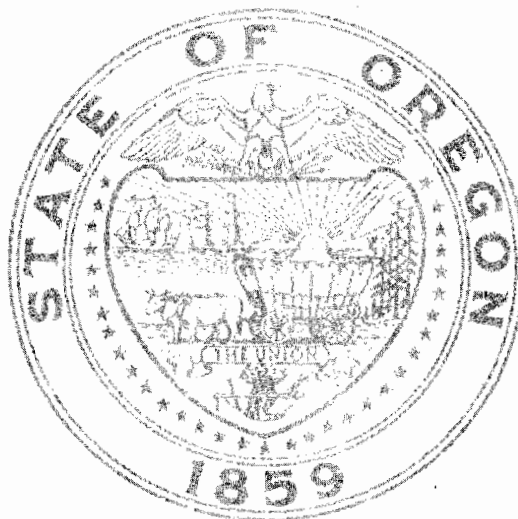
