This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DESCHUTES COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 120. The date of priority is 1886.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.6 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION BEING WITHIN THE NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.; 910 FEET SOUTH AND 160 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.; 200 FEET NORTH AND 1150 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 21.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
