 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KATHRYN LICHTER
 ROUTE 2, BOX 47
 WOODBURN, OREGON 97071

confirms the right to use the waters of LICHTER WELL #1 in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 1.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5214. The date of priority is JANUARY 12, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

5 S	1 W	WM	22	SW SW	1600 FEET SOUTH & 1300 FEET WEST from the NE Corner, NW¼ SW¼, Section 22

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 44869, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 06 2005, approving Transfer Application 6992.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
