CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES W. HART  
33200 S. CROOKED RIVER HIGHWAY

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE BEAR CREEK, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 18.00 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 1735. The date of priority is August 15, 1913. This right is limited to 0.225 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 1881, State Record of Water Right Certificates, CLARIFIED by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 0 8 2005, and recorded in Special Order Volume 65, Page 1. This certificate supersedes Certificate 1881.

This is an order other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
