CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEO. B. TAYLOR AND ALEATHA Z. TAYLOR
PRINEVILLE, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE BEAR CREEK, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 82.00 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 1735. The date of priority is August 15, 1913. This right is limited to 1.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right described by Certificate 1881, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT CLARIFIED OR MODIFIED by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 0 8 2005, and recorded in Special Order Volume 65, Page 1. This certificate supersedes Certificate 1881.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
