This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

Routine maintenance of the dam, spillway and appurtenant structures shall be performed as necessary to remove trees, brush and debris, and to repair slumps, areas of erosion, or defective equipment.

The earthen dam and resultant reservoir shall be maintained according to the approved plans and specifications on file with the Oregon Water Resources Dam Safety program.

The existing structure shall not be enlarged, modified, altered or otherwise changed without the prior written approval of the Director of the Water Resources Department or Director's authorized representative.
