CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EMERY AND BEULAH GUNTER

confirms the right to use the waters of a SLOUGH, tributary of the JOHN DAY RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 3.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 5594. The date of priority is AUGUST 1, 1922. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.041 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion located in the NE¼ SE¼, SECTION 28, T 13 S, R 30 E, WM; 1650 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER, SECTION 28, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Watermaster, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Watermaster prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Watermaster.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 15, 1981, at Special Order Volume 35, Page 439, approving Transfer Application 4902, and together with orders entered October 30, 1981, at Special Order Volume 35, Page 334, and November 29, 1989, at Special Order Volume 43, Page 476, both cancelling portions of the water right, supersedes Certificate 5792, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
