confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the McKAY CREEK BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 15.46 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7969, with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 30, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or the equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 52821, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by voluntary cancellations contained within the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered and recorded in Special Order Volume 65, Page 85, approving Transfer Application 9645.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
