CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN IRELAND 9195 NW HIGHWAY 47 FOREST GROVE OR 97116 MERLE A. AND MARILYN PETERS 3380 NW HIGHWAY 47 FOREST GROVE OR 97116

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK DAIRY CREEK, a tributary of the DAIRY CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 38.1 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 26.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-20968. The date of priority is DECEMBER 5, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.40 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.24 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.16 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in Certificate 81184 that was issued to confirm the right modified by provisions of two orders recorded at Special Order Volume 64, Pages 505 and 507, diminishing the water right evidenced by Certificate 23492. This certificate corrects and supersedes Certificate 81184.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
