 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R P GEORGE
 KERBY OR 97531

confirms the right to use the waters of WOOD CREEK, a tributary of the WEST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 17 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is 1871. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.34 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:


The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, from April 1 to November 1 of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
