CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EDWARD R. STUEDLI
1345 PINE GATE WAY
CENTRAL POINT, OREGON 97501

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION of 37.7 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 40004. The date of priority is APRIL 16, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.45 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 8 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 29, T 35 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 960 FEET SOUTH AND 1280 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTRION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 8 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) 14.4 ACRES
SECTION 29


NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 12.9 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 6.4 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 4.0 ACRES
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 75605, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 29 2005, approving Transfer Applications 8996 and 8997.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
