CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BRUCE CARPENTER
2435 ARROWPOINT CT
MEDFORD, OREGON 97504-3638

confirms the right to use the waters of LOST CREEK RESERVOIR
CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8142, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for
IRRIGATION of 9.9 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 51161. The date of priority is
OCTOBER 11, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled
is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not
exceed 14.85 ACRE FEET STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of
rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

RIVER - LOT 8 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 29, T 35 S, R 1 W, W.M.;
936 FEET SOUTH AND 1215 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 29.

RESERVOIR - SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 26, T 33 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 2000
FEET SOUTH AND 1700 FEET EAST OF THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount
secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited
to a diversion of 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ACRE FEET PER ACRE or its equivalent for each
acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be
further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 14.85 acre-feet per
year, and this permit is subject to the terms of Contract No. 3-07-10-
W0972, or satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation
and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the
Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant
is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 9.6 ACRES

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 0.3 ACRES

SECTION 30

TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 75606, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 29 2005, approving Transfer Applications 8996 AND 8997.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
