## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BRUCE CARPENTER 2435 ARROWPOINT CT MEDFORD, OREGON 97504-3638

confirms the right to use the waters of LOST CREEK RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8142, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 9.9 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 51161. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 14.85 ACRE FEET STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

RIVER - LOT 8 (NW4 NW4), SECTION 29, T 35 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 936 FEET SOUTH AND 1215 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 29.

RESERVOIR - SE'A NW'A, SECTION 26, T 33 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 2000 FEET SOUTH AND 1700 FEET EAST OF THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 4½ ACRE FEET PER ACRE or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 14.85 acre-feet per year, and this permit is subject to the terms of Contract No. 3-07-10-W0972, or satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
