## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN AND KATHY GRAHAM 300 LAMPMAN ROAD GOLD HILL, OREGON 97525

confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 1.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 2906. The date of priority is APRIL 26, 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.018 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the original point of diversion located SE¼ NW¼, Section 22, T 36 S, R 3 W, W.M. (North 55 Degrees West 2508 Feet to NW Corner, Section 22).

The authorized point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the following additional conditions:

- 1. **Prior** to diverting water, the water user **shall** install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 2. Prior to October 1, 2006, the water user **shall** install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.
