CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. E. Phipps  
Medford, Oregon

confirms the right to use the waters of the Rogue River, a tributary of the Pacific Ocean, for irrigation of 12.03 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 2906. The date of priority is April 26, 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.152 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 22, T36S, R3W, W.M..

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

12.03 ACRES SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
SECTION 22  
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 52204, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 30 2005, approving Transfer Application 8064.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
