confirms the right to use the waters of EIGHT MILE CREEK, a tributary of FIFTEEN MILE CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 10.8 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 29863. The date of priority is JULY 14, 1964. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.133 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW4 NE4, SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.; 800 FEET SOUTH AND 1980 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
