 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
 WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the DESCHUTES R, a tributary of the COLUMBIA R, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 1, 1899. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed the following rates for the specified portion of the irrigation season:

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 74145, point of diversion #15, located at:


To river mile 120 (Lake Billy Chinook) located approximately in the NE ¼ SW ¼, Section 29, T 12 S, R 12 E, W.M.

The instream right established by this transfer shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.3451, 537.346, 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 74145, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 61, Page 630, approving conserved water application C-13, and together with the quantity of water allocated to the applicant and the remaining right, supersedes Certificate 74145, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
