CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That Wm. Sendlinger

of Mosier, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Mosier Creek and Spring in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 19, T. 2 N., R. 12 E., W.M.
for the purpose of Irrigation, Domestic & Garden

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 10, at page 48; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from Jan. 21, 1909, for irrigation; and
1909, for Domestic & Garden

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed $\frac{1}{60}$ th of a second-
foot per acre or a total of 3 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season
from March 1st to October 1st, and outside of the irrigation season not to exceed
 $\frac{1}{10}$ th of a cubic foot per second for domestic and stock use.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

7.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 19,
T. 2 N., R. 12 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
