 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
 WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the GABLE CREEK, a tributary of the BRIDGE CREEK, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-39680. The date of priority is DECEMBER 17, 1974, plus one minute. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.052 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND during the specified March 1 to August 2 irrigation season, and shall be further limited to not exceed 16 acre-feet during the irrigation season of each year.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 46646, located at:

12 S	21 E	WM	8	NW NE	900 FEET SOUTH AND 760 FEET EAST FROM THE N ¼ CORNER, SECTION 8

To the MOUTH of GABLE CREEK, located approximately in:

11 S	21 E	WM	28	NE

The instream right established by this allocation of conserved water shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 46646, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm the portion of Certificate 46646 modified by an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 63, Page 151, approving Conserved Water Application C-31, and together with the that portion of Transfer 9104 originating from Certificate 46646, supercedes Certificate 46646, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 46646, and any related decree.
