CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL #1 in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 127.68 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9342. The date of priority is April 30, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1.596 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 27, T 14S, R 12E, W.M.; 1280 FEET NORTH
AND 2620 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 31.83 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 31.85 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 32.00 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 32.00 ACRES

SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 64020, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 11 2005, approving Transfer Application T-9818 and correctly describes the water right holders, superseding Certificate 81532.

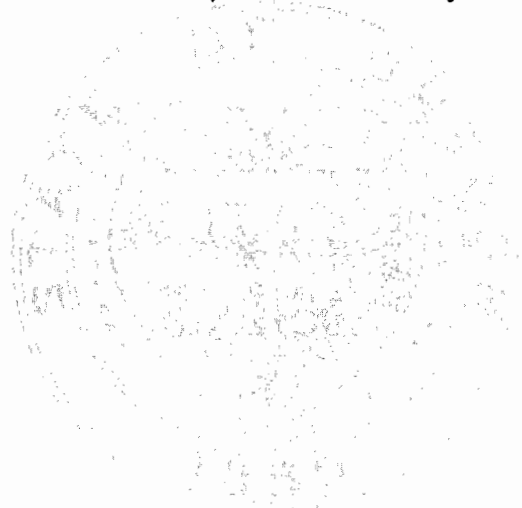
The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
