 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ESTATE OF A. L. HAND  
 ROUTE 2, BOX 78  
 MILTON-FREEWATER, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL, a tributary of DUGGER CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 6.0 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 5.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2295. The date of priority is November 9, 1962. The right is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.138 cubic foot per second (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 4.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


