CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOMAS J. AND EDITH K. SINN  
9510 SARATOGA DRIVE SE  
SILVERTON, OREGON 97381

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 68.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11003. The date of priority is JANUARY 13, 1989. This right is limited to 0.55 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.;  
175 FEET NORTH AND 1520 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF  
SECTION 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4	24.8 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4	35.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4	8.2 ACRES

SECTION 18  
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

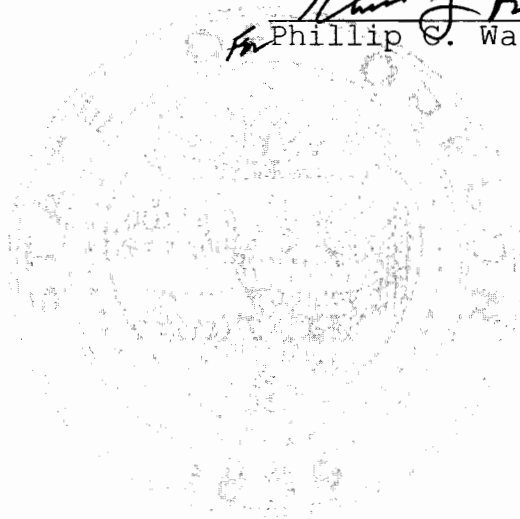
This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 81334, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 11 2005, approving Transfer Application T-9888.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
