CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARIE FLORA ROUTE 2, BOX 96 CANBY, OREGON 97013

confirms the right to use the waters of GRIBBLE CREEK, a tributary of the MOLALLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.53 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 23161. The date of priority is AUGUST 19, 1954. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.022 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN J. GRIBBLE DLC 38, SECTION 21, T 4 S, R 1 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2-1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.53 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN J. GRIBBLE DLC 38
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.
