confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION of 25.5 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 4034. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE% NW%, SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 15 RODS SOUTH AND 100 RODS EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
