 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OTTO CANTRALL
 RUCH OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of the APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 124.64 ACRES and LIVESTOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 2, at Page 339. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 1, 1857. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.48 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
