## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES M. MCGRATH 18400 SE PAULINA HWY PRINEVILLE OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 3.8 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-26204. The date of priority is MAY 29, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion. The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 for a non-completed portion of a change in point of diversion approved by of an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 15, 2004 at Special Order Volume 60, Page 527, approving Transfer 9520, and cancelling Certificate 36935. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
