CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HARRIS M. HAYDEN
KERBY, OR 97531

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 9.8 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is May 1887.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ 9.8 ACRES
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 13874 , State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 12, 2005 , approving Transfer Application 8372.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
