CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Confirms the right to use the waters of Calapooia River, a tributary of the Willamette River, for providing non-electrical power for operation of a Flouring Mill.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Linn County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 529. The date of priority is 1858.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 23.0 CUBIC FOOT FEET PER SECOND.

A description of the lands under the right to which the water is appurtenant is as follows:

NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ , of Section 8, Township 13 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

The period of use shall be from October 1 and ending April 30 of each successive year

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 26506, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 17, 2005, approving Transfer Application T-9896, and modifies the season of use allowed under the right, as well as correcting the spelling of the name of the source stream.


This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60days following the date the petition was filed, the petition will be deemed denied.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
