## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GRANDE RONDE VALLEY IRRIGATION CO. 205 MAIN ST LA GRANDE OR 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 393.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-1248. The date of priority is MARCH 9, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 5.1 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion described as being within the NE¼ NE¼, Section 5, Township 3 South, Range 38 East, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 79199, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 13, 2006, approving Transfer Application T-10026.
The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
