CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

T.J. CHENEY
PENDLETON, OR 97801

confirms the right to use the waters of McKay Creek, a tributary of the Umatilla River, for IRRIGATION of 40.8 acres of land, domestic and stock use.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is 1880.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.51 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation is subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE of SE 16.2 Acres

SE of NE 9.6 Acres

SW of SW 15.0 Acres


TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.
