CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT, DISTRICT OFFICE

MEDFORD, OREGON 97504

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS within the JUMP-OFF-JOE CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 24.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4488. The date of priority is JANUARY 15, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, being 0.24 cubic foot per second from Well No. 1 and 0.01 cubic foot per second from Well No. 2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL #1 - SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 9, T 35 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 120 FEET NORTH AND 70 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 9; and
WELL #2 - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 9, T 35 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1100 FEET SOUTH AND 930 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 39871, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 22, 2006, approving Transfer Application T-6826.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
