CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT, DISTRICT OFFICE  
3040 BIDDLE ROAD  
MEDFORD, OREGON 97501

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION NO. R-44177, PERMIT NO. R-5104, a tributary of JUMP-OFF-JOE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 23.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 33008. The date of priority is OCTOBER 20, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 9, T 35 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 120 FEET NORTH AND 220 FEET WEST FROM CENTER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5104.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$             0.8 ACRE  
NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$             23.0 ACRES  
SECTION 9  
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 39886, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 22, 2006, approving Transfer Application 6826.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
