CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT DISTRICT OFFICE

MEDFORD, OREGON 97501

confirms the right to use the waters of reservoir constructed under Application NO. R-45707, Permit NO. R-5413, a tributary of JUMP-OFF-JOE CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 30.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 34095. The date of priority is JANUARY 15, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 10.4 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 9, T 35 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 120 FEET NORTH AND 220 FEET WEST FROM CENTER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ 0.8 ACRE
NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ 29.5 ACRES
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 39888, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 22, 2006, approving Transfer Application 6826.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
