CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT, DISTRICT OFFICE

MEDFORD, OREGON 97501

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO.2, a tributary of JUMP-OFF-JOE CREEK for USE IN ADMINISTRATION BUILDING AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 2.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5299. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 19, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, being 0.02 c.f.s. for use in the Administration Building, and 0.03 c.f.s for supplemental irrigation, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 9, T 35 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 230 FEET NORTH AND 430 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ 2.4 ACRES & USE IN ADMINISTRATION BLDG.  
SECTION 9  
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 47288, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 22, 2006, approving Transfer Application 6826.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
