 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of LOSTINE RIVER, a tributary of WALLOWA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 17.5 acres, DOMESTIC and STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Pages 200, 201, and 202. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.50 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31<sup>st</sup> of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season ; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 3, 2006, approving Transfer Application 9430, and together with Certificate 81644 supersedes Certificate 81223, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
